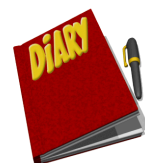

*'Two are better than one, because if either of them falls down, one can help the other up.'*

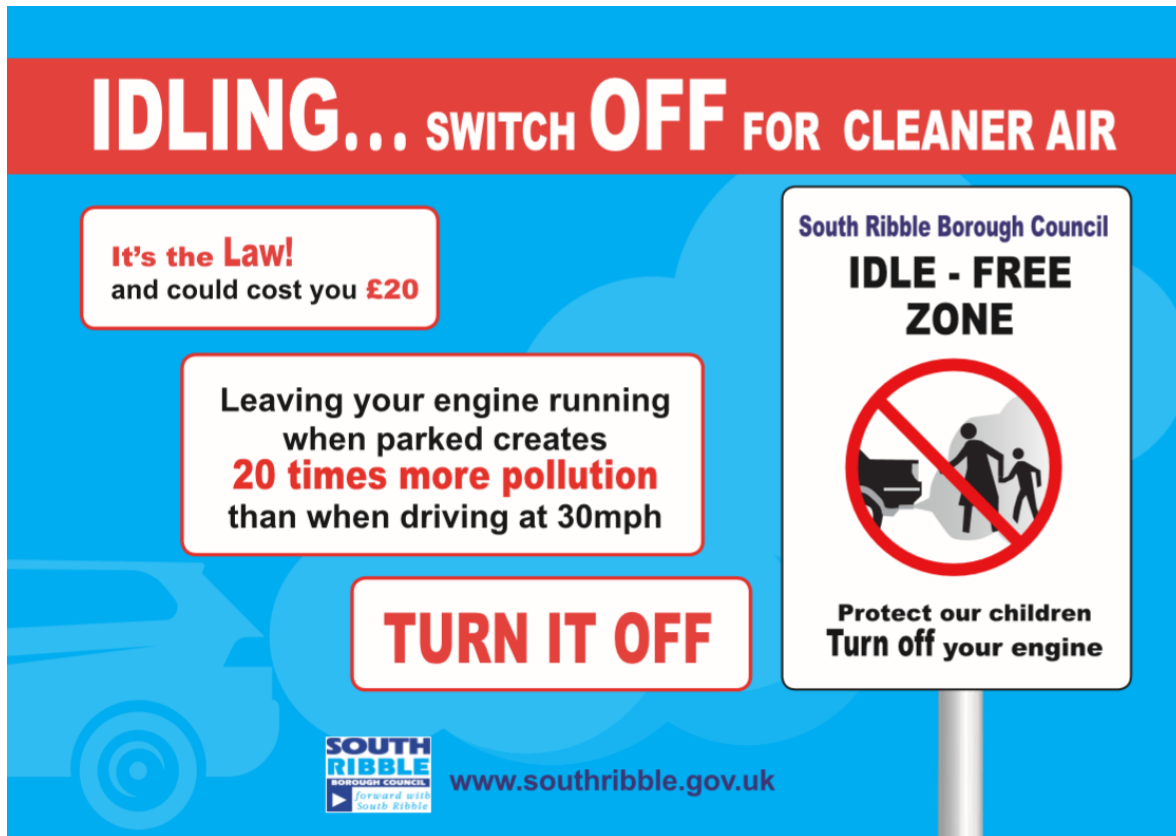
Ecclesiastes 4:9

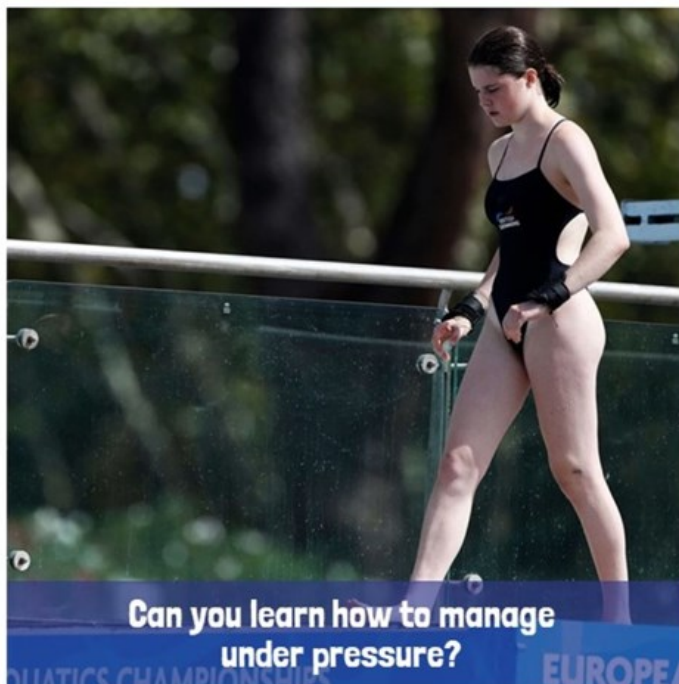
