- Governors discussed and reviewed the potential pipework upgrade for the areas served by the air source heat pumps and the options available.






Governors lived out the Christian vision by working together to ensure that all decisions continue to enable the children in school flourish.

PTFA Break the Rules Day

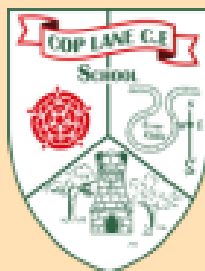
Thank you for all your support with the 'Break the Rules Day' last Friday. The PTFA raised a fantastic £368.45.
