The Christian Aid non-uniform day is now Thursday 18th May. This is because of a whole football festival taking place on Friday. Sorry for the confusion.

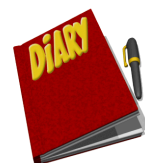

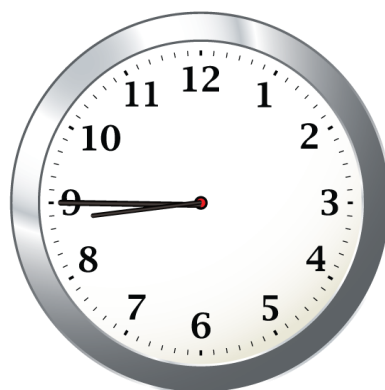
Governor Update






School opens at 8:45am



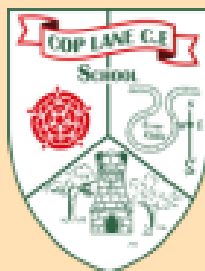

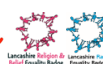

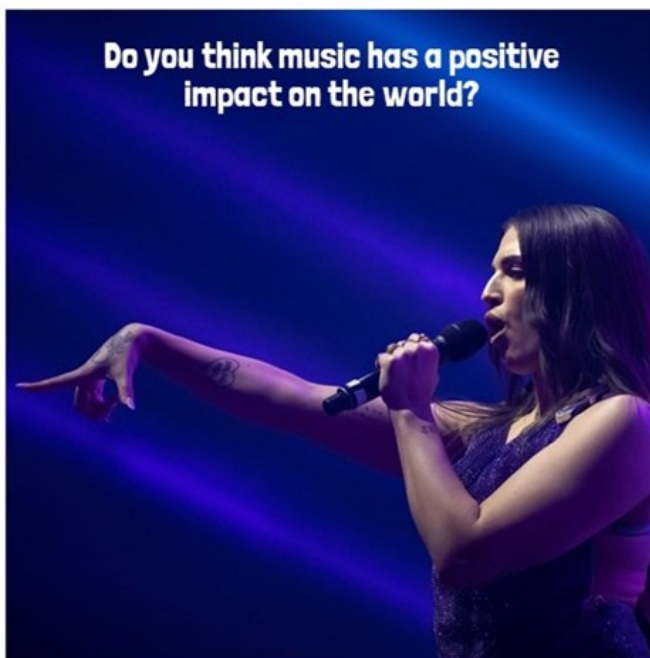
