

Reflection Time

'He clothed, sheltered and educated over 10,000 orphans without asking for a shilling.'

George Müller

This week in our worship, we heard the story of George Müller, who set up several orphanages for children. Every time the orphanages needed something, George prayed and laid his requests before God. Then he waited, believing that God would be faithful. Sometimes, the answers to his prayers only came at the very last minute. However, God answered the prayers each time and all of the orphanage's needs were met, often through other people and their kindness. George's faith grew so much in the end, he had helped thousands of orphans, all without asking for a penny, except God.
