
If your Junior child usually brings their own packed lunch and would like to have the Spud-tacular Special Lunch, please pay £2.90 via the Eduspot link.

If your Infant child has a packed lunch and would like the Special Lunch, just contact the office and they can be added on.


No payment is required for children in Rec, Y1, Y2 as all infants qualify for universal free school lunches.
