"All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak... as the Spirit enabled them."

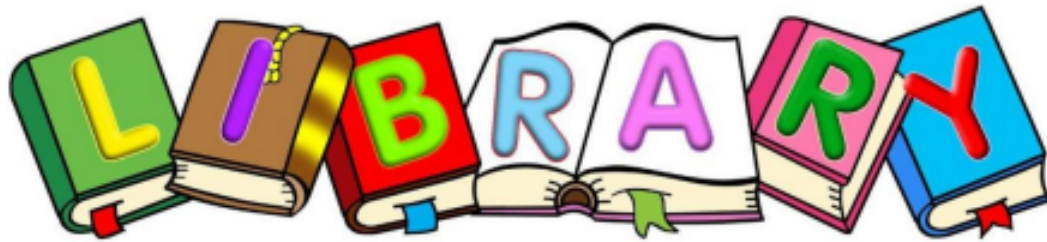
Acts 2:4

This week in worship, we talked about Pentecost, a very special moment in the Christian calendar. Pentecost reminds us of the day when the Holy Spirit came to Jesus' disciples, filling them with courage, joy and the power to share God's love with the world. We linked it to 'The Lion, the Witch and Wardrobe'. In the story, Aslan gives his life to save others and then comes back to life again. When he rises, he is full of strength and power, and everything around him begins to change. Frozen stone statues are brought back to life, hope returns and others are renewed with energy to stand up for what is right. This is just like Pentecost where the Holy Spirit empowered the disciples to begin to spread the news of Jesus.

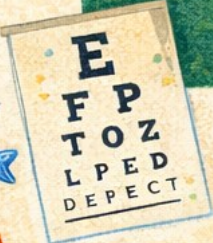

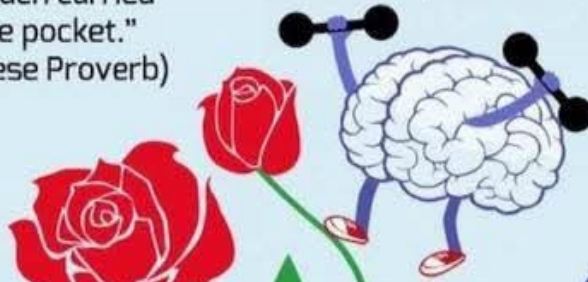
