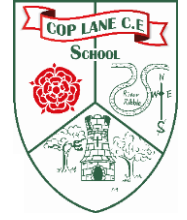


# Cop Lane's Child Friendly Behaviour Policy





At Cop Lane all pupils, staff and visitors have:

- We clear away after ourselves.

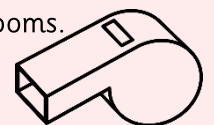
